Fall Creek Falls State Park Campground Renovation Announced

Fall Creek Falls State Park is pleased to announce the construction phase of a major campground renovation has started and should be completed in the fall of 2007.

The project includes the complete renovation of all 50 campsites in Area 'A', new electrical system to all campsites, adding sewer hookups where possible, and the replacement of the 'A' Area bathhouse. There will also be extensive work in and around bathhouse #3 in 'B' Area, renovation to campsites 128 through 143 and possibly other work in Area 'B' as funds allow. In addition, several of the sites in the affected areas will be made handicap accessible.

The downside to such a major renovation is the necessity of the <u>total closing</u> of all campsites in the affected areas for the duration of the construction phase.

During this renovation process, Fall Creek Falls State Park will not be taking any camping reservations. We expect this "No Reservations" policy to remain in effect for the calendar year 2007 only. The park apologizes for the inconvenience this will cause our dedicated campers but feel it is necessary due to the large number of "reservation" sites that will be closed.

We are excited about what these renovations will mean to the future of camping at Fall Creek Falls and ask that everyone bear with us during these "improving" times.
