LOCATION: Intersection of Persimmon Ridge Road and Route 11E, 2 miles east of downtown Jonesborough. Washington County.

WATERSHED DESCRIPTION: Unnamed tributary to Unnamed Tributary of Little Limestone Creek, Nolichucky River Watershed (HUC 06010108). Subject property is scrub/shrub and scattered areas of second growth timber all altered by past land use disturbances and fill material. The unnamed tributary traverses the property and has undergone past alterations with portions in a well defined channel and others with concrete fill material. Surrounding land use is commercial, Route 11E and scattered woodlots.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The applicant proposes to construct a commercial development consisting of several large buildings. The proposed project will require the relocation of approximately 750 linear feet of the unnamed intermittent tributary.

Compensatory stream mitigation will occur onsite with the establishment of a new 840 foot channel. The stream side will be planted with a variety of tree and shrub stakes and seedlings on two foot centers in alternating rows.

The permittee will monitor the relocated channel and guarantee successful establishment of a defined bed and bank and 75% survival rate for five years.

The division's Land Use Restrictions shall be placed on the relocated channel.

In accordance with the Tennessee Antidegradation Statement (Rule 1200-4-3-.06), the division has determined that the proposed activity will not result in degradation to water quality

The request must be filed within the comment period, indicate the interest of the person requesting it, the reasons that the hearing is warranted, and the water quality issues being raised. When there is sufficient public interest in water quality issues, the department will hold a public hearing.




In deciding whether to issue or deny a permit, the department will consider all comments on record and the requirements of applicable federal and state laws.




