LOCATION: Houston Levee Road between the Wolf River and Macon Road, east of Raleigh LaGrange Road; Collierville, Shelby County.

WATERSHED DESCRIPTION: The proposed project in the Wolf River watershed. HUC 08010210. Surrounding land use is upland forests, residential, agricultural fields, a school and scattered wetlands. Wetland areas are dominated by cattails, sycamore, sedges, black willow, smartweed and lizards tail. Three of the four to be impacted are linear drainage wetlands. Marys Creek, and unnamed tributaries will be crossed by the proposed project. None of the stream or wetlands are Tier 11 or high quality waters.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The applicant proposes to construct improvements to Houston Levee Road. The proposed project is 4.605 miles in length. The purpose is to provide a safe roadway to carry traffic on this road in a rapidly expanding portion of Shelby County. The proposed project will require the placement of fill in four wetland areas totaling approximately 0.24 acres. In addition, the project will require the crossing of Marys Creek and unnamed tributaries to Grays Creek for a total of 250 linear feet.

Compensatory wetland mitigation shall occur off site north of the Wolf River and south of Raleigh LaGrange Road on the Humphreys Tract in Collierville. Wet species of native trees, primarily mast producing, shall be planted on ten foot centers on 0.96 acres of Falaya soils. Hydrology will be the construction of a small berm at the downhill portions of the mitigation site to retain surface water, runoff and potentially flooding for the Wolf River.

The applicant shall monitor the wetland mitigation and submit annual reports to this office for at least five years.
