LOCATION: southeast of Spring Hill, south of Coil Road, west of I-65 and south of

Saturn Parkway. Spring Hill, Maury County.

WATERSHED DESCRIPTION: Upper Duck River Watershed (HUC 06040002). Surrounding land use is residential and a school. The unnamed tributary on site flows diagonally across the site into Rutherford Creek. Approximately 12.5 miles of Rutherford Creek is on the 2006 303(d) list. The causes are loss of biological integrity due to siltation and nutrients. The pollution sources are minor municipal point source and land development. The unnamed tributary is 1-2 feet wide, 1-2 feet deep and lined with grass.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The applicant is proposing to relocate approximately 475 linear feet of an unnamed intermittent tributary to Rutherford Creek. This relocation will allow for the development of a cul-de-sac and seven additional lots. The new channel will be approximately 3-4 feet wide and 3 feet deep with 2:1 slopes. Native trees will be planted in two alternating rows along the top of both banks. Several in-stream habitat features will be included such as root wads and drop-log structures. The stream relocation shall be monitored with annual reports submitted to this office.

In accordance with the Tennessee Antidegradation Statement (Rule 1200-4-3-.06), the division has determined that the proposed activity will not result in degradation to water quality
