- NRS 06.122 City of Portland The division has determined that the City of Portland has failed to sufficiently justify their proposal to degrade Caney Fork Creek, a high quality stream. This is a determination under the "Antidegradation Policy" rather than a permit decision.
- NRS06.280 Memphis and Shelby County Port Commission proposed to dredge approximately 250,000 cubic yards from the mouth of the Pidgeon Industrial Harbor in Shelby County. ISSUED
- NRS06.352A City of Kingsport proposed to install approximately 14,294.62 ft. of gravity sewer line that would cross an unnamed tributary to Miller Branch, Miller Branch, and an unnamed tributary to Reddy Creek in Sullivan County. ISSUED
- NRS07.048 ADM River Port proposed to perform sediment dredging at its barge facility, McKellar Lake, Memphis, Shelby County. ISSUED
