**LOCATION:** Unnamed tributary to South Chestuee Creek, Highway 411 near Benton

Polk County 35.1545 °N, -84.7086 °W

**WATERSHED DESCRIPTION:** The unnamed tributary to South Chestuee is in the Hiwassee watershed (HUC 06020002) and has not been assessed by the division for its support of classified uses. Its designated uses of fish and aquatic life, irrigation, livestock watering and wildlife, and recreation. The stream has an average width of 1 - 2 feet wide and a substrate of bedrock, mud and shale fragments. A high-gradient stream habitat assessment yielded a score of 124. The stream has indicators of perennial flow and has a forested riparian zone. The tributary was determined to be Tier I during a July 2007 assessment.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The applicant proposes to impound 316 linear feet of the tributary for a pond. The stated purpose of the pond is for livestock watering.

The proposed dam would be 14 feet. The pond outlet would be a pipe spillway with a hooded inlet. The fill for the dam would be excavated within the dam site and impoundment zone. Approximately ½ acre will be cleared for the dam construction. There is proposed a gravity fed cattle watering tank to exclude any livestock from the impoundment.

In accordance with the Tennessee Antidegradation Statement (Rule 1200-4-3-.06), the division has determined that the proposed activity may result in degradation to water quality.

No decision has been made whether to issue or deny this permit. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties of this permit application and to ask for comments and information necessary to determine possible impacts to water quality. Persons wishing to comment on the proposal are invited to submit written comments to the department. Written comments must be received within **thirty days of the date that this notice is posted**. Comments will become part of the record and will be considered in the final decision. The applicant's name and permit number should be referenced.

Interested persons may also request in writing that the department hold a public hearing on this application. The request must be filed within the comment period, indicate the interest of the person requesting it, the reasons that the hearing is warranted, and the water quality issues being raised. When there is sufficient public interest in water quality issues, the department will hold a public hearing.

The permit application, supporting documentation including detailed plans and maps, and related comments are available at the department's address for review and/or copying. The department's address is:




Figure 1: USGS topographic map with project area indicated




Figure 2: Proposed dam design
