WATERSHED DESCRIPTION: The project site is in the Upper Duck watershed (TN 06040002) and the segment is fully supporting of its classified uses. The classified uses for the streams are fish and aquatic life, recreation, irrigation, livestock watering and wildlife, domestic water supply and industrial water supply. The Duck River in this area is a Class II Scenic River (Pastoral River Area) and Tier II (Exceptional Tennessee Waters). The surrounding landuse is predominately rural/agricultural.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The applicant proposes to construct a private access ramp to the right descending bank of the Duck River. The ramp will consist of a regarding of the area to less than a 45-degree slope, lining with geotextile fabric and placing crush rock on top. The ramp will be over 15 feet in length. The applicant consulted with the Natural Resource Conservation Service and states the ramp is for making the private access handicap accessible.

In accordance with the Tennessee Antidegradation Statement (Rule 1200-4-3-.06), the division has determined that the proposed activity will not result in degradation to water quality.

No decision has been made whether to issue or deny this permit. Comments will become part of the record and will be considered in the final decision. The applicant's name and permit number should be referenced.

Interested persons may also request in writing that the department hold a public hearing on this application. The request must be filed within the comment period, indicate the interest of the person requesting it, the reasons that the hearing is warranted, and the water quality issues being raised. When there is sufficient public interest in water quality issues, the department will hold a public hearing.

In deciding whether to issue or deny a permit, the department will consider all comments on record and the requirements of applicable federal and state laws.




Figure 1: USGS topographic map with the project area indicated




Figure 2: Aerial photo of the site




Figure 3: Plan sketch for the proposed access ramp
