DEER BAG LIMITS

One antlerless deer per hunt, except where otherwise specified.

- A East of Hwy. 330 and east of Briceville Hwy. only
- B Bag limit 2 antlerless deer
- West of Hwy. 411 and east of Hwy. 129
- D Excludes Cherokee WMA
- E Excludes Chickasaw WMA
- F Sevier County north of Hwy. 411

FALL TURKEY SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS

- Nov. 10-16: 1 turkey, either sex, per permit
- Asterisk (*) indicates counties with 2 hunt dates: Nov. 10-16 and Dec. 10-14. Combined bag limit for these hunts is 3 turkeys, either sex, per permit.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. You may begin applying on July 26, 2007. You must apply at a TWRA license agent, at any TWRA regional office, or by online application at www.tnwildlife.org. If you encounter any problems while applying, call 615-781-6621 during regular office hours (8-4:30 CT).
- 2. No person may apply more than once.
- 3. You have up to 8 choices, including any combination of deer and turkey hunt choices. Do not use the same hunt code choice more than once. You will only be drawn for up to 5 permits. Each applicant is eligible for only 1 permit per hunt.
- 4. A party leader will CREATE the party, select the hunt choices, and the number of drawings. A party number will be assigned to the leader, and anyone wishing to JOIN the party must have that party number when applying. Party numbers are assigned once the application is processed and are printed on the receipt. A party may not exceed 15 members.
- 6. Applicants must review their application receipt and verify name, address, hunt locations, party number (if joining a party), fees, etc., upon completion to ensure accuracy.
- No applications will be accepted or edited after the deadline.

WHEN APPLYING AT A LICENSE AGENT:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or seniors possessing a Type 167 permit. For all other applicants, there is a \$20.00 permit fee for each drawing you enter, plus a \$1.00 agent fee.
- When applying in person, you must remain until your application is processed to ensure that your information is correct and to receive your receipt with your confirmation number.

WHEN APPLYING ON THE INTERNET:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or seniors possessing a Type 167 permit. All other applicants, in addition to the \$2.00 internet usage fee, will be charged a permit fee of \$20.50 for each drawing entered. The \$2.00 internet usage fee is collected by the company that maintains the internet site. (It is not a fee that is charged by the TWRA.)
- Go to www.tnwildlife.org. Click on "Online Licensing."

SPECIAL SEASONS DRAW INFORMATION:

- 1. A computer drawing will be held to determine successful applications based on the priority drawing system. If any hunt quotas remain unfilled after the first drawing, a second drawing will be conducted to fill the quota. This drawing will be repeated up to maximum of 5 times if necessary to fill all quotas. The priority drawing system is exclusive to the first drawing; priority is not considered in the second drawing.
- 2. Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mail. If unsuccessful in the drawing, fee(s) submitted will be refunded. Receipt and deposit of permit fees do not constitute permission to participate in the hunt.
- 3. No applicant will be drawn for a second or subsequent hunt until all applicants have had a chance to be drawn for one hunt.
- 4. In order to be drawn with priority, applicants must apply either (a) alone: or (b) in a party in which all applicants have priority. If a party includes a member who does not have priority, that party (and all its members) will be drawn at zero priority.
- 5. Drawing Procedures: Using the "luck of the draw" method, an applicant or party of applicants is randomly selected by the computer. The first hunt choice is compared to the vacancies that may exist for that hunt, and if there is a vacancy, they are assigned that hunt. If not, the second choice, etc. (in order), are examined until the applicant or party is assigned a hunt, or runs out of hunt choices.
- **Permits are not transferable.** No refunds will be made after the drawing to anyone issued a permit. If you wish to apply for more than one drawing, it is possible to be drawn on the same date in different counties.
