Hunt Choices

(List hunt codes in order of preference.)

Party Number (if joining a party)

DEER HUNTS

Table with columns: Code, County, Date, Quota. Lists 61 deer hunt entries across various counties.

FALL TURKEY HUNTS

Table with columns: Code, County, Quota. Lists 127 fall turkey hunt entries across various counties.

DEER BAG LIMITS

One antlerless deer per hunt, except where otherwise specified.

- A East of Hwy. 330 and east of Briceville Hwy. only
B Bag limit - 2 antlerless deer
C West of Hwy. 411 and east of Hwy. 129
D Excludes Cherokee WMA
E Excludes Chickasaw WMA
F Sevier County north of Hwy. 411

FALL TURKEY SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS

- Nov. 10-16: 1 turkey, either sex, per permit
Asterisk (*) indicates counties with 2 hunt dates: Nov. 10-16 and Dec. 10-14. Combined bag limit for these hunts is 3 turkeys, either sex, per permit.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. You may begin applying on July 26, 2007. You must apply at a TWRA license agent...
2. No person may apply more than once.
3. You have up to 8 choices, including any combination of deer and turkey hunt choices.
4. A party leader will CREATE the party, select the hunt choices, and the number of drawings.
5. Applicants must review their application receipt and verify name, address, hunt locations, party number (if joining a party), fees, etc., upon completion to ensure accuracy.

WHEN APPLYING AT A LICENSE AGENT:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or seniors possessing a Type 167 permit.
When applying in person, you must remain until your application is processed to ensure that your information is correct and to receive your receipt with your confirmation number.

WHEN APPLYING ON THE INTERNET:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or seniors possessing a Type 167 permit.
Go to www.tnwildlife.org. Click on "Online Licensing."

SPECIAL SEASONS DRAW INFORMATION:

- 1. A computer drawing will be held to determine successful applications based on the priority drawing system.
2. Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mail.
3. No applicant will be drawn for a second or subsequent hunt until all applicants have had a chance to be drawn for one hunt.
4. In order to be drawn with priority, applicants must apply either (a) alone: or (b) in a party in which all applicants have priority.
5. Drawing Procedures: Using the "luck of the draw" method, an applicant or party of applicants is randomly selected by the computer.
6. Permits are not transferable. No refunds will be made after the drawing to anyone issued a permit.

Most hunting lands in these counties are privately owned. Issuance of a permit does not guarantee permission to hunt.
