# WATERFOWL SEASONS



**Reelfoot Duck Zone** is defined as "the lands and waters within the boundaries of Reelfoot Lake WMA only."

**The Statewide Duck Zone** is defined as "the remainder of the state outside the Reelfoot Lake Duck Zone."

#### YOUTH WATERFOWL HUNTING SEASON

#### For youths 6-15 years of age

Reelfoot Duck Zone - (Closed during statewide segment) Feb. 9-10, 2008

Statewide Duck Zone- (Reelfoot Duck Zone closed during this segment) Feb. 2-3, 2008

An adult at least 21 years of age must accompany the youth hunter into the field and must remain in a position to take control of the hunting device. The adult accompanying the young hunter may not hunt ducks but may participate in other open seasons. Geese, coots, gallinules, moorhens, and ducks, including pintails and canvasbacks, may be taken by youths during Youth Waterfowl Season. WMAs with special closing times are open all day, each day of the Youth Waterfowl Season.

**BAG LIMIT** - Same as statewide bag limits. See Daily Bag Limits.

# DAILY BAG LIMITS

**DUCKS** – 6 birds, and may include no more than 4 mallards (no more than 2 of which may be female), 1 black duck, 2 wood ducks, 1 pintail, 2 canvasbacks, 2 scaup and 2 redheads.

**COOTS AND GALLINULES** - 15

MERGANSERS – 5 (only 2 of which may be hooded mergansers)

## VIRGINIA AND SORA RAILS - 25

### **POSSESSION LIMIT**

Twice the daily bag limit except on opening day. Rails same as daily bag limit.

#### **BLUE, SNOW & ROSS' GEESE**

STANDARD SEASON – Standard Federal Regulations Apply (Unplugged Shotguns and Electronic Calls NOT Allowed) Nov. 25, 2007 – Feb. 10, 2008

DAILY BAG LIMIT -20 blue, snow, and Ross' geese

**POSSESSION LIMIT** – There is no possession limit for blue, snow, and Ross' geese except on opening day when it is the same as the daily bag limit

CONSERVATION SEASON – For Blue, Snow, and Ross' Geese Only Feb. 11 – March 10, 2008

# WHITE-FRONTED GEESE

STATEWIDE SEASON -Dec. 1 2007- Feb. 10, 2008

DAILY BAG LIMIT - 2 white-fronted geese

**POSSESSION LIMIT** – Twice the daily bag limit except on opening day.

#### BRANT

STANDARD SEASON -Nov. 23, 2007 - Jan. 31, 2008

DAILY BAG LIMIT - 2 brant

**POSSESSION LIMIT** – Twice the daily bag limit except on opening day.

# **CANADA GEESE**

DAILY BAG LIMIT – 2 Canada geese in all zones

**POSSESSION LIMIT** – Twice the daily bag limit except on opening day.

KENTUCKY/BARKLEY LAKES ZONE (those counties or portions thereof west of Hwy. 13 not included in the Northwest and Southwest MVP Zones)
